I understand that as Pastor I am expected to pay from our parish a subsidy of \$800 per student for the 2018-2019 school year to St. Paul Catholic School. I further understand that during the course of the year, I may revoke the subsidy if the family is not following the standards established by the parish. If this happens, I will notify the school and the family would be expected to pay the full tuition rate to St. Paul Catholic School.
