Enclosed you will find your summer reading assignments. You will be reading one book for school. The book is called Dear Mr. Blueberry by Simon James.

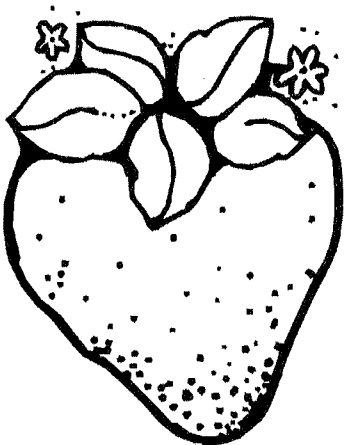

Have a great vacation and I look forward to seeing you all in August!

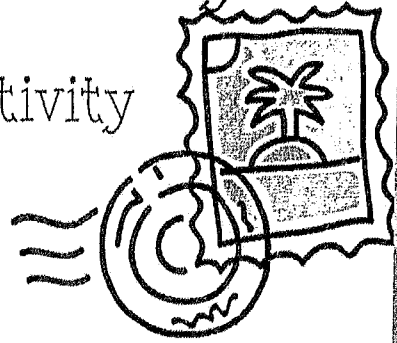

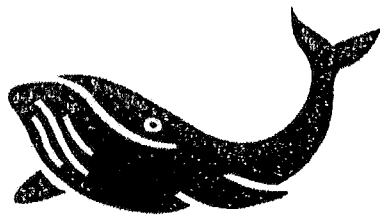

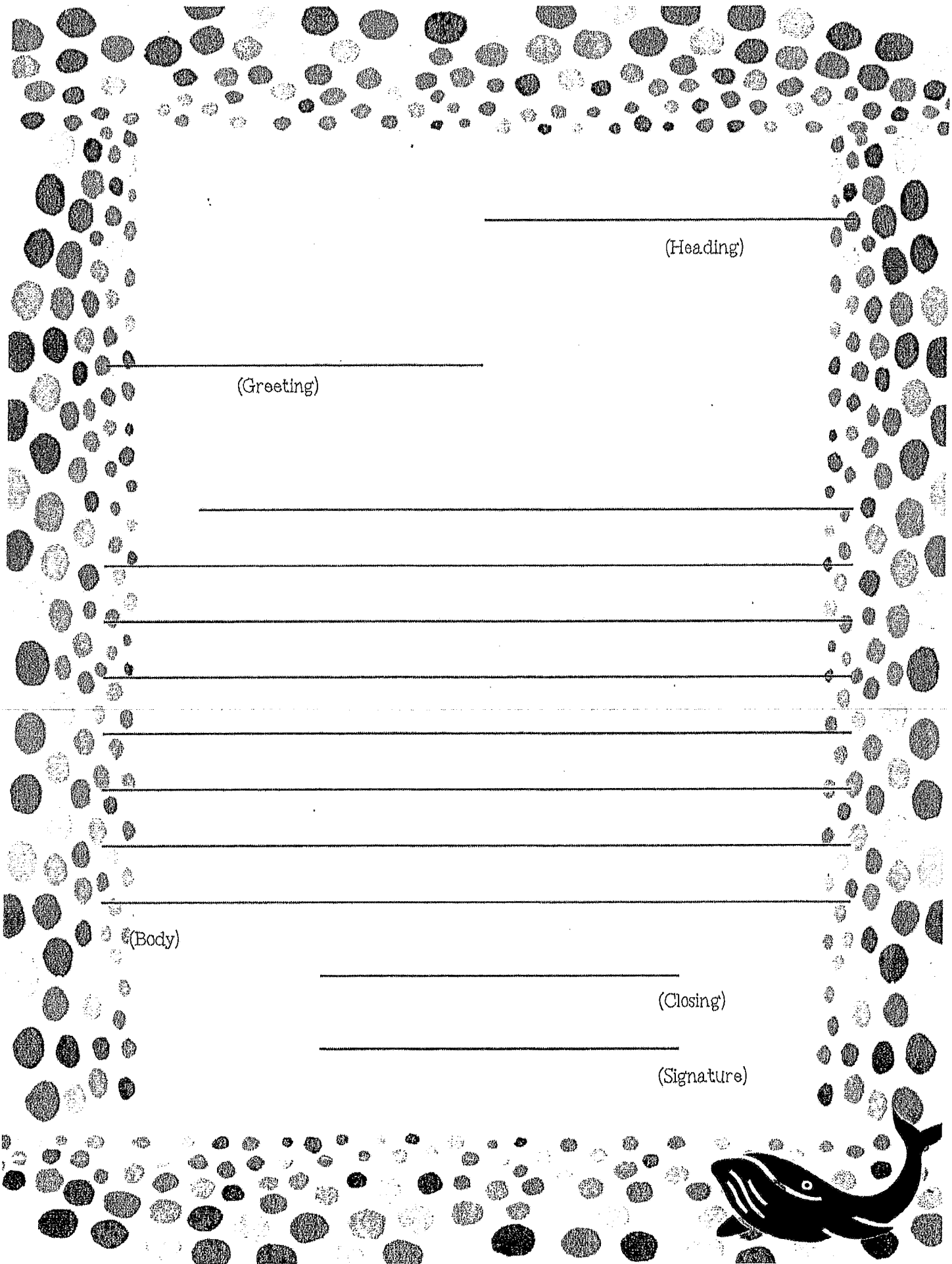
Letter Writing Activity

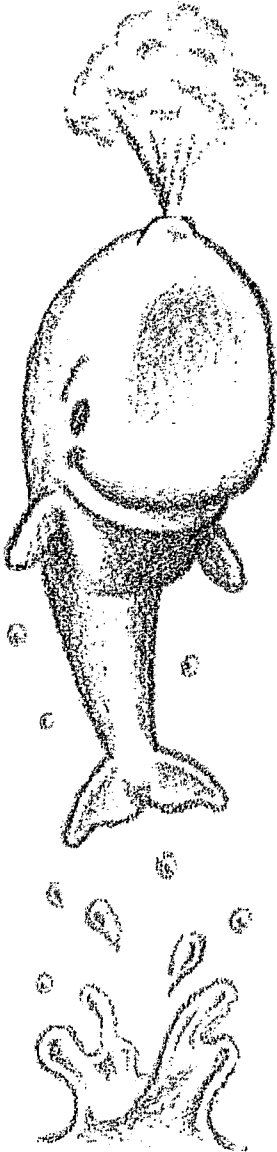

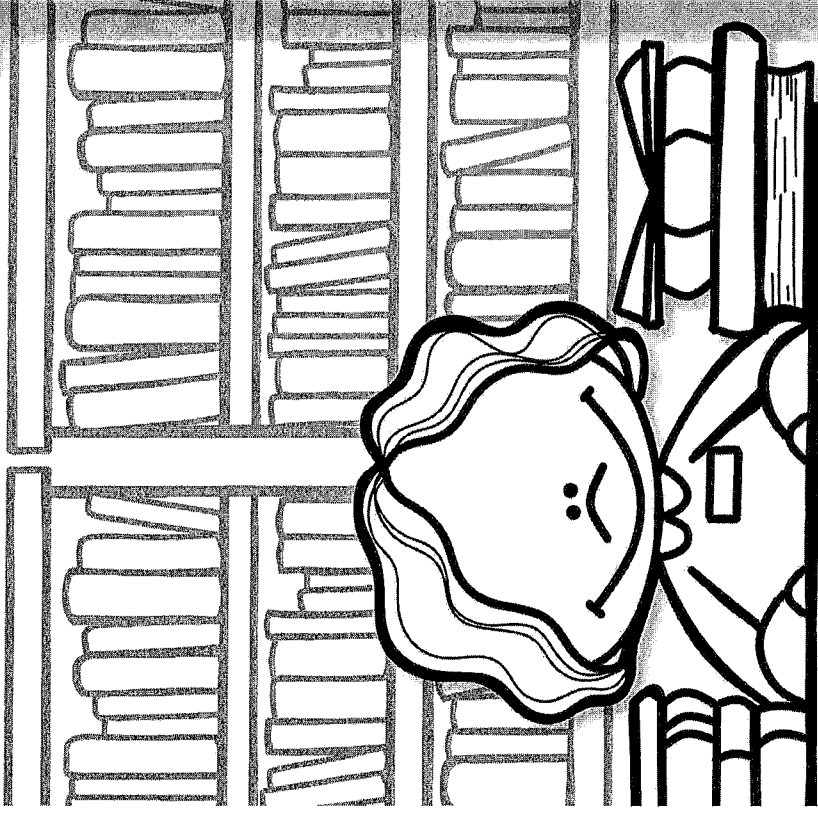
